Black Hills Spruce <i>Picea glauca</i> <i>Densata</i>	2	35-40'	15 - 20'	full sun	none	none	none	Large dense slow growing tree, good for wind screening.
Colorado Spruce <i>Picea pungens</i>	3	60'	15 - 20'	sun/shade	none	none	none	Very hardy, needles vary from green to blueish, great winter cover for birds.
Columnar Norway Spruce <i>Picea abies</i>	2	40-80'	25-30'	Full Sun	none	none	none	The largest and fastest growing of the spruces. Large cones are attractive as Christmas ornaments.
Dwarf Alberta Spruce <i>Picea glauca</i> 'Conica'	4	5'	3'	Full Sun	none	none	none	Very slow growing, conical, miniature spruce. Bright green new growth changing to blue-tree.
Fat Albert Spruce <i>Picea Pungens</i> 'Fat Albert'	3	10-15'	8 - 12'	full sun	none	none	none	Dense stocky tree, slow grower 6-8" per year.
Sester Dwarf Spruce <i>Picea pungens</i> 'Sester Dwarf'	2	6'	4 '	Full Sun	none	none	none	Requires full sun for best performance.
Bristlecone Pine Tree <i>Pinus aristata</i>	4	8-20'	10-15'	Full Sun	none	none	none	Large and in charge. Slow grower, drought tolerant, beautiful figure.
Limber Pine <i>Pinus flexilis</i>	4	45'	20 '	full to partial shade	none	none	none	One of the most tolerant of cold, windy weather in the winter and is not cold damaged when most other pines show needle browning. Has outstanding ornamental features.
Mugo Pine Tree <i>Pinus mugo</i> <i>pumilio</i>	2	4'	6 '	Full sun	none	none	none	Attractive mounded shape that can be maintained by pruning. Especially nice in early summer when new candles of growth appear. Very hardy and rugged.
Scotch Pine <i>Pinus sylvestris</i>	3	25-50'	20-30'	full sun	none	none	none	thick, conical shaped evergreen, becoming more rounded with age
Rocky Mountain Juniper <i>Juniperus scopulorum</i>	3	30'	15'	Full Sun	none	none	none	Extremely drought tollerant, but still likes moist soil. Good for ornamental landscaping and excellent for cover and nesting.
Skyrocket Juniper <i>Juniperus scopulorum</i> 'Skyrocket'	4	15 '	2-4'	Full Sun	none	none	none	Once established, needs only occasional watering. Great to use as a privacy screen or windbreak.

Haralred Apple <i>Malus domestica</i> 'Haralred'	3	10-30'	15 '	Sun	pinkish white	red	brilliant red	Hardy tree with a juicy tart apple
Haralson Apple <i>Malus domestica</i> 'Haralson'	3	10-30'	15 '	Sun	White	red to red striped	red orange	Hard, crisp apples, tart, often bares fruit the first year, late season bloomer, fall harvest.
Honeycrisp Apple <i>Malus</i> 'Beacon'	4	15-20'	15 '	Sun	White	yellow with mottled red	orange-ish yellow	Hardy tree with fruit that is exceptionally crisp with a juicy flesh and slightly tart flavor to it. The fruit stores very well.
