Aster 'Aster'	12 - 18"	sun - part	purple, blue, lavender	Summer - Fall	Attracts butterflies, grows in a compact form, tolerates poor soils, moderate water needs.	3
Bell Flower 'Campanula'	4-30"	sun - part	assorted	Summer - Fall	Varied group, trailers, upright tufts. Attracts pollinators, prefers avg-moist soil, good in rock gardens, edging, rock walls.	3
Bee Balm 'Monarda'	3-4'	sun - part	pink, purple, red, magenta	Midsummer - Early Fall	Attractive to bees, butterflies, and birds. Prefers an organically enriched soil, moderate water needs, has a nice basil-mint smell, deer resistant.	3
Blanket Flower 'Gaillardia'	14-24"	sun	red, yellow	Early Summer - Fall	Native, tolerates dry soils. Works for rehabilitating disturbed sites, in low-maintenance beds, and good food source for pollinators/wildlife.	3
Blue Flax 'Dianella'	16-20"	sun	blue	Late spring - Summer	Reliable, feathery foliage, drought tolerant, helps control erosion. Provides forage value for livestock/wildlife through spring/winter.	3
Bleeding Heart 'Dicentra'	1-3'	sun - part	red, pink	Spring	Native plant that does well in loose, moist soil. Good for woodland gardens, borders, containers, cutting gardens, mass plantings.	3
Black-Eyed Susan 'Rudbeckia'	2-3'	sun	golden yellow	Summer	Showy flower, bold texture and upright flower, good for cutting, attracts butterflies. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, does well in poor soils.	3
Columbine 'Aquilegia'	16-24"	sun - part	assorted	early spring - mid summer	Attracts hummingbirds/butterflies, prefers organic loose mediums. Useful for meadow and woodland plantings, easily regenerated by seed.	3
Cranesbill Geranium 'Geranium'	6-18"	sun- part	pink, blue, purple, white	Early summer - Fall	Mounding, long season display w/fall color. Not picky with soil, moderate water needs. Use towards front of a border\massing\mixed containers.	3
Creeping Phlox 'Phlox Subulata'	6-8"	sun	pink, red, white, purple	Spring	Dense colorful ground cover, good for rock gardens, hillsides, walkways, garden borders. Drought tolerant once established.	3
Mountain Bluet 'Centaurea'	1-2'	sun	Blue with Purple Center	Late Spring/Early Summer	Unique shaggy flower sits on busy grey-green leaves. Attracts pollinators, tolerant of most soils, remove spent flowers to encourage repeat blooms.	3
Delphinium 'Delphinium'	4-5'	sun	white, blue, purple	June - August	Good for cottage gardens, back of beds or borders. Deer/rabbit resistant. Likes alkaline soil. From flower-pod stage palatable/toxic to livestock.	3
Dianthus 'Dianthus'	8-20"	sun	pink, white, red	May - September	Great for rock gardens, borders, slopes, edgings. Easily grown in medium moisture soils with good drainage. Deer resistant, showy, low maint.	3
Daylily 'Hemerocallis'	14-28"	sun	assorted	June - August	Low maintenance once established, tolerant of differing soil types. Moderate watering needs, showy blooms, great for cut flowers.	3

Globe Flower 'Trollius'	6-24"	a.m. sun	yellow	Late Spring - Early Summer	These globeflowers tend to grow in heavy moist soils, great for moist woodland and pond-side settings. Foliage shape gives nice garden contrast	2
Geum 'Geum'	6-15"	sun - part	red, orange, yellow	Summer	Flowers rise above neat clumps of foliage. Deer resistant, attracts pollinators, good for partially shaded spaces that need a pop of color.	4
Hollyhock 'Alcea'	5-8'	sun	white, pink, red, yellow, purple	late summer/early fall	Biennial perennial, average water needs - water regularly, do not overwater. Attractive to bees, birds, and butterflies, and cut.	3
Heuchera 'Heuchera'	12-18"	sun - part	pink, red, white	Late Spring/Early Summer	Coral bells flowers are very popular with the hummingbirds. Foliage makes nice addition to gardens, moderate water needs, mulch in winter.	3
Helenium 'Helenium'	12-30"	sun	red, orange, yellow	Summer - Fall	Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies, does well in most soil types, moderate water needs, deer and rabbit resistant (toxic to animals).	3
Heliopsis 'Heliopsis'	18-24"	sun - part	yellow	Summer - Fall	Will bloom most with more sun. Prefer well-drained soil without too much organic matter or fertilizer. Remove spent blooms for repeat blooms.	3
Iris 'Iris'	12-24"	sun	assorted	Spring	Nice foliage and likes rich, well drained soils. Try not to mulch over the rhizomes, keep them dry to prevent rot. Use low-N fertilizer in spring/fall.	3
Lupine 'Lupinus'	18-36"	sun - part	red, pink, purple, white	June	Great color in early summer, will bloom again if deadheaded, good drainage needed. Seed pods toxic to sheep. Deer resistant.	3
Lamium 'Lamium'	8-12"	Part sun	rosy-purple	Spring - Fall	Tough yet showy groundcover, heart shaped leaves with silvery stripe down the middle. Flower clusters off and on throughout summer into fall.	2
Lady's Mantle 'Alchemilla'	18-24"	Shade	Chartreuse (yellow-green)	Late Spring/Early Summer	Great accent plant, helps to hide dying leaves of early spring bulbs, deer resistant. Subtle elegance for shady spaces, water beads on leaves oo-la-la.	3
Monkshood 'Aconitum'	3-5'	sun - part	blue, white	Summer	Grows best in rich, moist soil. Blooms may require staking, deer resistant. ***Toxic beauty, Use caution w/young children and curious pets around.	2
Nepeta Catmint 'Nepeta'	24-36"	sun - part	white, pink, lavender-blue	Late Spring - Fall	Aromatic foliage, attractive to pollinators, deer resistant. Great for wildlife gardens, lacey shape and grey-green foliage contrast.	3
Oriental Poppy 'Papaver Orientale'	30-36z"	sun	red, orange, pink, white	Mid summer	Showy, colorful, single stemmed flowers. After bloom entire plant diesback to conserve energy, plant late-blooming varieties around to avoid gaps.	3
Obedient Plant 'Physostegia'	1-4'	sun - part	pink, white, purple	late summer/early fall	Stems can be bent to stay in place (obedient), deer resistant, bees and pollinators love love love.	3

Peony 'Paeonia'	24-36"	sun - part	white, pink, red	Mid - Spring	Shrub-like flower, old favorites, beautiful cut flowers, fragrant. Deer tend to avoid, avg maintenance, needs good spacing, place in low-traffic areas.	2
Penstemon 'Penstemon'	10-30"	sun	pink, purple, red, blue	May - July	Attracts hummingbirds/butterflies, drought tolerant, good for cutting. Performs best in well-drained soil.	4
Snow on the Mtn 'Euphorbia'	6-15"	sun-shade	white	July-September	Fast spreading ground cover with variegated foliage. Low maintenance, deer/rabbit/drought tolerant. Showy.	2
Snow in Summer 'Cerastium'	4-6"	sun	white	May - June	Silver leaved, low fast spreading, mat-like ground cover. Beautiful spilling over rock walls or steep sunny slopes. Good choice for difficult sites.	2
Sweet Woodruff 'Galium Odoratum'	6-9"	shade	white	May - June	Great ground cover for shady sites, in moist conditions will spread to form thick carpet. Great to disguise foliage from spring bulbs as they die back.	3
Shasta Daisy 'Leucanthemum'	24-36"	sun	white with yellow	Early Summer - Fall	Will bloom many weeks if deadheaded. Attracts pollinators and birds, make great cut flowers, attractive border.	3
Soapwort 'Saponaria'	6-8"	sun	pink	Late Spring	Ground cover, nice for edging, walls, borders. Does well in many soil types including clay, tolerates some foot traffic, deer resistant.	3
Salvia 'Salvia'	18-24"	sun	purple, pink	Summer	Nice cut flower, attracts bees to the garden, deer resistant. Moderate water needs. Remove spent flowers to encourage new blooms.	3
Sedum 'Sedum'	4-24"	sun	yellow, pink, white	May - August	Assorted ground covers and upright succulents, drought tolerant. Good for south facing beds or hellstrip gardens.	2
Speedwell 'Veronica'	12-14"	sun - part	blue, purple, white, pink	Spring - Fall	Nectar rich, upright flowers. Great used in borders, mixed containers, and cut flowers. Thrives in avg. fast draining soils. Deer resistant.	4
Thyme 'Thymus'	2-4"	sun - part	pink, lavender, white	Early Summer	Fragrant ground cover. can use as drought tolerant lawn substitute, in between pavers, along walkway, and in rock gardens.	2
Yarrow 'Achillea'	18-36"	sun	yellow, white, pink, red, orange	June-September	Good for cutting, drought resistant, wildlife gardens, prefers well-drained soil in full sun but can be grown in less-than ideal.	3
